





The new book "Labour Markets in Low-Income Countries: Challenges and Opportunities" by David Lam and Ahmed Elsayed addresses some of the most important issues affecting labour markets in low-income countries. The programme has contributed to the growing interest in understanding labour markets in the poorest countries by producing high-quality research outputs and policy documents, as well as through interactions with various stakeholders and impacts on programmes and policies.
